ORDER

WHEREAS, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section(2) of Section 32 of the National Council for Teacher Education Act, 1993(73 of 1993), and in supersession of the National Council for Teacher Education [Recognition Norms and Procedure] Regulations, 2009, the National Council for Teacher Education has notified the Regulations, 2014 on 1.12.2014.

2. AND WHEREAS, the institution, **Lisieux College of Education, Sathy Main Road, Saravanampatty, Coimbatore – 641035, Tamilnadu** has by affidavit consented to come under New Regulations and sought for two basic units in **B.Ed** which require additional facilities.

3. AND WHEREAS, on scrutiny it is found that the institution has not shifted to its own premises as stipulated in its Formal Recognition order dated **14.12.2006**.

4. AND WHEREAS, the SRC has decided to permit the institution to have two basic units of 50 students each subject to the institution fulfilling following conditions namely,

- I. The institution shall submit all documents including land, building, Encumbrance Certificate, Land Use Certificate, Building Plan, approved staff list, pertaining to shifting to own premises to the SRC before 31st July, 2015 failing which recognition will be withdrawn.
- II. The Regional Committees shall inspect the proposed premises during August-September-October, 2015 and if on inspection it is found that the institution does not fulfill required norms of infrastructure recognition will be withdrawn.
- III. Further, with regard to the second unit the institution shall create additional facilities that include (a) additional built-up area, (b) additional infrastructure, (c) additional funds, (d) additional staff as per Regulations, 2014 and inform Regional Committees with required documents by October 31, 2015.
- IV. The applicant-institution for additional unit will be required to submit the required documents such as land documents, Encumbrance Certificate (EC), Land Use Certificate (LUC), Building Plan (BP) and the Approved Staff List in the specified proforma available on the website to the Regional Committee in proof of having provided additional facilities before October 31, 2015. Building Completion Certificate (BCC) may be given along with other documents if available, otherwise it can also be given to the Visiting team at the time of inspection.
- V. The Regional Committees shall arrange for verification of documents, inspection of these premises and check adherence to these conditions by 20 Feb, 2016. If it is found by the Regional Committee that the institution fails to comply with these requirements, the institutions shall not be permitted to admit students for the academic year 2016-2017.

5. NOW THEREFORE, in the light of the above and in terms of Section 14(3) of NCTE Act and in accordance with the Regulations, 2014, the Southern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby grants recognition to **Lisieux College of Education, Sathy Main Road, Saravanampatty, Coimbatore – 641035, Tamilnadu** for conducting **B.Ed** programme of two years duration with an annual intake of **100** students each for two basic units from the academic session **2015-16** subject to fulfilment of the conditions mentioned at 4.(I) and 4.(II) herein before 31st July, 2015 and those mentioned at 4.(III), 4.(IV) before 31.10.2015.

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6. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfilment of other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/Body, the State Government etc, as applicable.

7. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self- Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a chartered Accountant.

8. The institutions shall maintain & update its web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure:-

- a) Sanctioned programmes along with annual intake in the institution;
- b) Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
- c) Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last quarter;
- d) Names of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
- e) Fee charged from students;
- f) Available infrastructural facilities;
- g) Facilities added during the last quarter;
- h) Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
- i) The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
- j) The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires.
- k) Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.

If the institution Contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the regional committee under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

ORDER

WHEREAS, the institution **Lisieux College of Education, Viswasapuram, Saravanampatti P.O., Coimbatore, Tamilnadu-641035** was granted recognition vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2006-2007/9620 dated 14.12.2006 for conducting B.Ed. course of one year' duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2006-2007.

AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted affidavit dt. 28.01.2015 for its willingness of two units in B.Ed. course and adherence of provisions of new Regulations.

AND WHEREAS, provisional revised recognition order was issued to the institution on 31.05.2015 for conducting **B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.**

AND WHEREAS, the matter regarding compliance by the institutions of the conditions of the revised recognition order, was placed before the SRC in its 369th meeting held on 28.01.2019 and the committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance.

AND WHEREAS, as per the decision a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 15.02.2019. The institution submitted its reply along with documents dt.04.03.2019.

AND WHEREAS, the matter placed before the SRC in its 382nd meeting held on 26th – 27th November 2019 and the institution has not submitted any documents as a result a Final Show Cause Notice was sent to the institution on 03.12.2019

AND WHEREAS, the institution has submitted its reply along with relevant documents on 12.12.2019.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed before the SRC in its 384th Meeting held on 12th & 13th February 2020 and placed the matter and decided to issue withdrawn order to the institution.

AND WHEREAS, as per the decision a Withdrawal Order was issued to the institution vide order no. F.SRC/NCTE/APSO4694/B.Ed./114979-114985 dt. 21.02.2020.

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AND WHEREAS, the Appellate Authority in NCTE vide order dt. 16.12.2020, remanded back the case of the institute to SRC. The operative part of the order is reproduced below: -

"AND WHEREAS Appeal Committee noted that appellant institution was granted recognition for conducting B.Ed. programme with an intake of 100 seats in the year 2006 on a leased land Appellant institution was issued revised recognition order under NCTE Regulation, 2014 and further the intake granted was reduced to 50 seats on 18.02.2016. intake for the programme having been reduced, appellant institution was not required to increase it built up area and infrastructural facilities. As stated by appellant, the institution continues to conduct the B.Ed. programme from its old land and building.

AND WHEREAS Appeal Committee decided that appellant is required to submit to SRC within 15 days of the issue of appeal order, (i) the land building documents and Corresponding CLU, N.E.C, Building Completion Certificate and printout of website. Appeal Committee further decided to remand back the case to SRC for revisiting the matter.

AND WHEREAS after perusal of the Memoranda of Appeal, affidavit, documents on record and arguments advanced during the online submission, Appeal Committee concluded to remand back the case to SRC for revisiting the matter.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council hereby remands back the case of Lisieux College of Education, Saravanampatti, Viswasapuram, Coimbatore North, Coimbatore, Tamilnadu to the SRC, NCTE, for necessary action as indicated above.

AND WHEREAS, as per Hearing Committee Instructions, the institution has submitted deficiencies rectified documents on dt. 29.12.2020.

AND WHEREAS, the compliance submitted by the institution on dt. 29.12.2020 and the matter was considered by the SRC in its 393rd Meeting held on 05th & 06th January 2021 as under: -

"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

*On the perusal of the reply submitted by the institution, the Committee decided that the continuation order be issued to the Institution **Lisieux College of Education, Coimbatore-641035, Tamilnadu** for B.Ed programme for 1 basic unit of 50 students."*

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
NOW THEREFORE, the SRC decided to permit the institution i.e., **Lisieux College of Education, SF. No. 48, 54/1 Part, 55 Part, 56 Part, 57 Part, 203, Viswasapuram, Ward No. 28, Saravanampatti P.O., Coimbatore, Tamilnadu-641035** for **B.Ed. course** run by **Carmelites of Mary Immaculate Education Society, Saravanampatti, Coimbatore District, Tamilnadu-641035** for continuation of recognition for **B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 students (one basic unit)** subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
 - II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
 - III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
 - IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.
 - V. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.
14. Further, the institution is required to fulfil all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/Body, the State Government etc. as applicable.
 15. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self – Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
 16. The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter – alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme(s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely: -
 - a. Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution:
 - b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
 - c. Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last, quarter:

- d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.
 - e. Fee charged from students.
 - f. Available infrastructural facilities.
 - g. Facilities added during the last quarter.
 - h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter.
 - i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
 - j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires.
 - k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.
17. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.
18. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.
19. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made of issued there under, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provisional of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

Also order that a copy of this Order be published in the official Gazette.
